Ismet Beqiri has lived in Pristina since 1968 where he finished primary and secondary school. Mr. Beqiri went on to law school at the University of Pristina. Since December 1981, he has been a member of the political party, "Democratic League of Kosova." This was the first pluralist and democratic party in Kosova and its region.

From May 1991 to April 2002, he was the Secretary of the first DLA Branch in Pristina. In 1998 he was elected deputy in the Kosova Parliament, in the Parliamentary and Presidential Elections (Parallel Government System, in the period when Kosova was still under the Serb Regime).

From 1991 to 2002, he worked as a professor at Technique High School "28 Nentori" in Pristina. In April 2002, he was elected President of the first DLA Branch. From June to November 2002 he was the Director of Public Municipal Company "Sportmarketing" in Pristina. In the local elections held in 2002 he was nominated to Deputy of the Municipal Assembly of Pristina and in November 2002, after the second elections for Local Government in postwar Kosova, he was elected Mayor of Pristina.

Ismet Beqiri was born in Pristina on 6 July in 1964. He is married and he has three children.
